### Detained Adult Program

During **91** jail visits to **5** jails, over **4,600** adult detainees received *know your rights* presentations, **1,660** adult detainees received individualized screenings & **92** received *pro bono* representation.

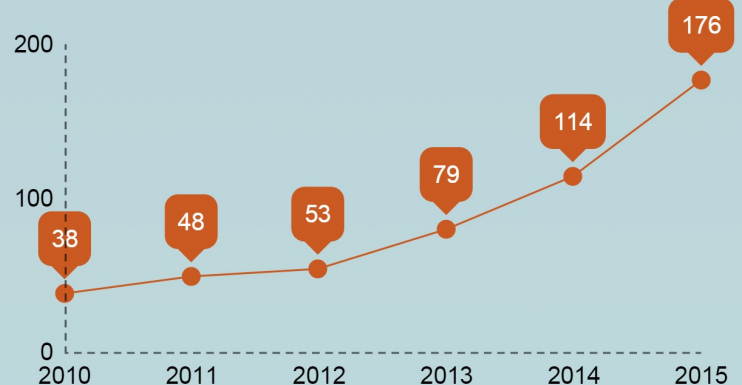
### Detained Children's Program

During **168** visits to **6** detention facilities, **546** detained unaccompanied immigrant children received legal assistance & **84** children received *pro bono* representation.

### Virginia Justice Program

- 140** individual case consultations on immigration consequences of criminal convictions.
- 18** trainings at public defender offices in Virginia.
- 5** practice advisories educating public defenders & defense attorneys about immigration consequences of VA criminal offenses.
